August 2, 2019 (DUBUQUE, IA) – The [Dubuque Museum of Art \(DuMA\)](#) will mark the closing weeks of summer and its current exhibits with two free community events in August.

The 2nd annual Family Art Carnival takes place on Saturday, August 10, 2019 from Noon-4 p.m. The free event will be held on 7th Street, in front of the Museum, and will feature both indoor and outdoor art activities, an animal petting zoo, and a bouncy house for children.

Admission to both the Family Art Carnival and museum will be free. In addition, the museum will offer guided tours of the [2019 DuMA Biennial](#) and ice cream treats. Hy-Vee Grill items will be available for purchase.

The free event is sponsored by Mediacom and U.S. Bank.

The 4th annual Movie at the Museum will take place on Saturday, August 17, 2019 in Washington Park. This year's featured film, as selected by the DuMA's Facebook followers, will be the Iowa classic "Field of Dreams" (1989), which marks its 30th anniversary this year.

Field of Dreams Ghost Players will be on hand before the film from 7 to 8:30 pm for a question and answer session.

The movie begins at dusk (approximately 8:30 p.m.). In the event of inclement weather, the movie will be cancelled.
