TRY THIS:

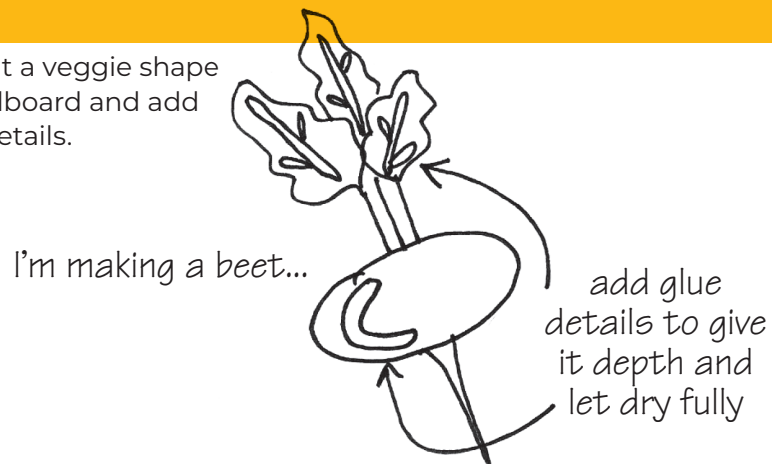
Create a pin of your favorite veggie. Wear it and make someone smile!

Supplies

- Colored aluminum foil (Sharpie markers work great)
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Glue and tape
- Safety pin

Step 1

Cut out a veggie shape in cardboard and add glue details.



Step 2

Cover your veggie shape with a thin layer of glue, then press colored foil over the top, let dry.

Step 3

Carefully pull the foil away around the outside of your veggie shape.

Step 4

Cut a little rectangle of paper to use as a tab to attach veggie to the safety pin.



Step 5

Wear your veggie pin proudly!
