Craft artist Linda Kelen begins by asking herself “Can I?” or “What if?” Her copper and silver spoons are done in the repousse (embossed) technique which means the design is pushed up from the reverse side.

TRY THIS:

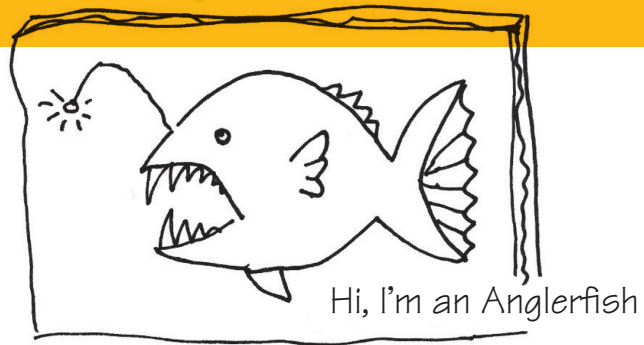
Create an embossed design inspired by artist Linda Kelen.

Supplies

- Cardstock
- Aluminum foil (a few inches longer than your board)
- Glue and glue stick
- Yarn or thick string
- Permanent markers or acrylic paint (optional)

Step 1

Draw your design on the cardboard.



Step 2

Squeeze glue onto all of your design's lines, then press yarn into the glue to outline your drawing and give it dimension.

LET DRY OVERNIGHT!



Step 3

Cover the non-shiny side of your foil piece with glue stick glue. Place it over your cardboard design and CAREFULLY rub the foil to fit it around the yarn design.

Step 4

Color your embossed design with markers or paint, leaving the raised outlines bare.
