Dubuque Baseball Classic - 2024

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the inaugural **Dubuque Baseball Classic – 2024!** This year’s theme is “Picturing America’s Pastime.” The conference celebrates our love for our National Pastime and our rich baseball history by sharing and discussing the images and stories from our baseball past. This event has been coordinated around two baseball exhibitions running at the Dubuque Museum of Art through June 16, 2024.

Picturing America’s Pastime: A Snapshot of the Photograph Collection at the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum exhibition explores the cultural history of America through the lens of the sport’s greatest photographers. This landmark exhibition comes from the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in Cooperstown, NY. 51 photographs span the years 1866 to 2012 and reflect some of the most memorable moments in baseball and American history.

Picturing Dubuque Baseball is a companion exhibition that reveals the role Dubuque and Dubuquers played in helping shape early Major League Baseball.

Event speakers will discuss one or more elements found in the exhibits from their own personal perspective and area of expertise.
